

Directions and Maps to Abington Hall

Road [we do not advise using our postcode in your sat nav]

From the North (via the A1 and the A14) Take the A14 and follow it to merge with the M11 at Junction 14. Leave the M11 at Junction 10, taking the A505.

From the West (via Bedford) on the A428 Leave the A428 at Madingley, take the A1303 towards Cambridge, join the M11 at Junction 13 and leave at Junction 10, taking the A505.

From the West (via Sandy) on the A603 Join the M11 at Junction 12 and leave at Junction 10, taking the A505.

From the East on the A14 Take the A11.

From the South via the A1 (West London) Leave the A1 at the A6141 exit for Baldock and take the A505.

From the South via the M11 (East London) Leave M11 at Junction 9 and take the A11.

Rail

Cambridge (many connections) approximately 10 miles/16 km

Audley End (London - Liverpool Street) approximately 10 miles/16 km

Whittlesford Parkway (London - Liverpool Street) approximately 2 miles/3 km

Air

Airports:

London Stansted - 21 miles/34 km

London Heathrow - 80 miles/130 km

London Gatwick - 95 miles/150 km

London Stansted is highly recommended to visitors from Europe. It is 30 minutes by car from Abington Hall Conference Centre and has direct connections with many European cities. You can travel from the airports as follows:

Stansted - Taxi to Abington Hall Conference Centre, coach or train to Cambridge.

Heathrow - Underground train to King's Cross and train to Cambridge, or Underground to Liverpool St. and train to Audley End or Cambridge, or coach to Cambridge or Stansted (then as from Stansted).

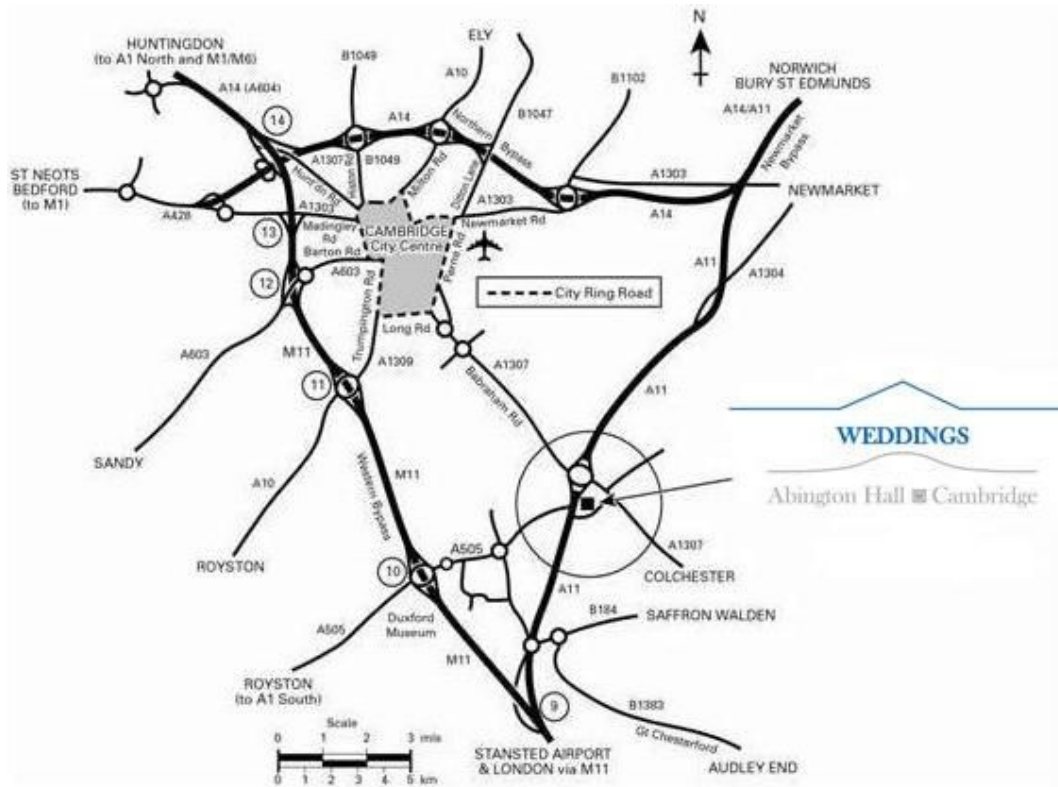
